- Produce a testimonial video where the scholarship recipient shares their experiences and the results achieved.

Application process

Interested parties must complete the application form, including the following documentation:

1. **Portrait photo** of the applicant.
2. **Brief Curriculum Vitae (CV)** (maximum 500 words).
3. **Usage proposal:** A short description of how you will use the platform in your academic training or professional practice (maximum 500 words).
4. **Proof of enrollment:** An official document including full name, academic program, institution, and country.
